**1. DISCUSSION AND ACTION ON OFFICIAL CANVASS OF THE MAY 7, 2016 CITY OF GREY FOREST JOINT GENERAL ELECTION**

Mayor Reinhard stated we are here this evening to Canvass the May 7, 2016 Joint General Election. He stated the election was held on May 7, 2016. The election was a Joint Election with Bexar County.   - Under Votes, 3 Total Votes

**2. ISSUE CERTIFICATE OF ELECTION**

The Unofficial Results of the May 7, 2016 Joint General Election were provided to City Council.
