Councilmember Thornton stated he's waiting on a lift to finish installation of the cameras. The Board requested he order two more cameras. They are in and he will finish mounting them when he's able to get the lift. Councilmember Nottingham stated Scenic Loop~Boerne Stage Alliance received the 2<sup>nd</sup> version of inscription from Texas Historical Commission for the Historical Marker. It was sent back to Austin and should be going to the foundry. They've identified a location for its placement and will be installed in limestone. They are working on and accepting donations.

### **POLICE DEPARTMENT ACTIVITY REPORT**

The June and July 2014 Monthly Activity Reports were reviewed. Chief Bejar stated a theft case was filed with the District Attorney's Office and the case was accepted. A warrant was issued and the suspect was picked up. They are currently waiting on a trial date. He would like to remind everyone to report suspicious activity.

### **PUBLIC WORKS ANNOUNCEMENTS**

Chris Mikel reviewed the June and July 2014 Monthly Activity Reports. He stated we are having a lot of problems with trees falling. He stated with Jacob going back to school in August, he has concentrated on two person projects over the last few months. It was discussed that CPS needs to be contacted and have their tree contractor come back out and clean up what was left from their recent tree trimming activity.

### **GFU UTILITY ANNOUNCEMENTS**

Councilmember Thornton stated the report on the Water Levels was recently sent to Council by email. It appears the levels came up a little after the recent rain.

### **FIRE DEPARTMENT REPORT**

Don Reddout stated there was 1 call in the City in June; assist with a lock out. In July there were 7 calls in the City; 2 EMS and 5 Fire. He stated remember if it's not medical, it falls under Fire but of those, 2 were fire related.

### **NEW BUSINESS:**

#### **1. CONSIDER AND ACT ON APPOINTMENT OF BOARDMEMBERS FOR EXPIRING TERMS ON THE BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT**

Councilmember Thornton stated the Board positions of Freda Hoffman and LeMoey Wiebush on the Board of Adjustment are expiring. He stated they have both expressed their willingness to serve on the Board of Adjustment for an additional two year term. There was discussion that it would be helpful to fill the two empty Alternate Board Positions. It was discussed the City could possibly advertise the open positions on the website and/or marquee to solicit individuals that may be interested in serving on the Board. The motion to reappoint Freda Hoffman and LeMoey Wiebush to the Board of Adjustment for a two year term was made by Councilmember Nottingham, seconded by Councilmember Tiner and passed unanimously.

There was no further discussion. Councilmember Thornton adjourned the Regular Council Meeting at 6:58 p.m.
