OLD BUSINESS

1. DISCUSS AND ACT ON DRAFT OF NEW ANIMAL ORDINANCE AND RECOMMENDATIONS REGULATING ANIMALS

Mayor Reinhard stated before Council is the new animal ordinance recommendations. He stated once Council has reviewed the Ordinance, it will need to be sent to our City Attorney for legal review. Additionally, he would like to have it reviewed by the Municipal Judge as he would handle all court enforcement of the Ordinance. Mayor Reinhard thanked Councilperson Nettle and Councilperson Thornton for undertaking this big task. Councilperson Nettle stated there were not many big revisions. Most revisions were taken out of the Helotes animal ordinance. Council reviewed the draft Ordinance in detail through page 14, Section 2.7. Minor wording changes and additions were noted for correction and or updating to the Ordinance. Councilperson Waldrop will look into page (8), (c) Quarantine Procedures (2) on how you determine if an animal is suspected to be rabid and who is qualified to determine it. Mayor Reinhard will look into the intentions of page (10), Sec. 2-1 Animal Care (d) "may not be sold at any time during the year within the city limits" and (f) "expose any know poisonous substance, whether mixed with food or not". Discussion and review of the draft Ordinance was finished on page (14), Section 2.7. It was Council's consensus to adjourn the meeting and continue discussions where left off in a workshop in the January/February time frame.

Mayor Reinhard adjourned the Regular Council Meeting at 9:26 p.m.
